## **Bergen – The city of culture**

In some way it is hard to think back 500 years to the time when the Hanseatic men ruled the city, when the stockfish was the main trade product in Bergen and the only drinking product available was beer. But when you stand on Bryggen today, you can still see some parts of that time. The sea right outside the doors, the buildings architecture and actually, in some parts of the town, you can still catch the scent of stockfish.

Bryggen has been damaged by a number of fires through the centuries and has been rebuilt after every fire, closely following the previous property structure and plan, as well as building techniques. Bryggen's appearance today steams from the time after the fire in 1702. Even though Bergen was not a Hanseatic city, it was a very important Hanseatic office(kontor). All the stockfish from the northern parts of Norway were traded here.

Today Bergen is a city filled with music, dance, art work and so much more. Several world famous composers, singers and bands have their birthplace in Bergen. As the next largest city in Norway we have direct routes to almost every part of the country. Here you can hike on the mountains early in the morning, take a fishing trip after lunch, and end the day with a wonderful meal at one of our great restaurant followed by a trip to a nightclub or a concert.

In June we welcome you to a celebration filled with numerous types of entertainment. Not only do we have the traditional Hansa Market but also a rich cultural program with artists from the Hanseatic cities as well as regional artists. As a city of gastronomy in the UNESCO Creative Cities Network, we are arranging a chef competition, which will focus on stockfish/dried fish, herring and beer.

Bergen is well-known for its hospitality and was a successful host for the Hanseatic days in 1996. In 2000 Bergen was the European capital of culture. The city has also been host of The Tall Ships Races several times and is honored to host the UCE Road World Championships in Cycling in 2017. We will do our best to give you unforgettable memories during your stay.



## What to do when you arrive in Bergen

Once you find your hotel and place to sleep there are several things you need to do.

1. Register your city at the accreditation/information stand located at the start of the Hansa Market, entrance from “Bryggen”. Meet your assigned volunteer.
2. At the registration you will receive one bag for each participant with information of the Hanseatic days. This will include:
  - Program for the delegates, Official Program and the Youth Hansa program,
  - Red wristbands for the HanseParty (those are for the once that bought tickets for the Hansaparty), free entrance for St. Mary’s Church and the Hanseatic Museum.
  - Yellow wristbands (limited access) for all other participants. The wristbands will provide you with free entrance at St. Mary’s Church and the Hanseatic Museum. Please use them during your stay.
  - Invitation for the Bergen reception, one invitation equals one person, please divide the invitations between your delegates.
3. Please check if everything is according to your registration and contact us immediately if you realize that something is wrong.
4. Receive a map with the location of your stand.
5. Setup your stand on Thursday 10:00 – 15:00.
6. If you ordered a Parking space for your car, please park it at the assigned spot. Separate map will be handed out.
7. Join the opening parade.
  - Each city is asked to line up at Festningskaaien ½ hour before the parades. Your assigned volunteer will guide you to the meeting place.
8. Opening hours for the Market, please note that is not allowed to enter the market by car during the opening hours.
  - Friday: 10:00-20:00
  - Saturday: 10:00-20:00
  - Sunday: 10:00-14:00
9. Remember to follow us on facebook and Instagram.
10. Dismantling time for Hansa Market Sunday from 14:00, dismantling should be finished on Sunday.

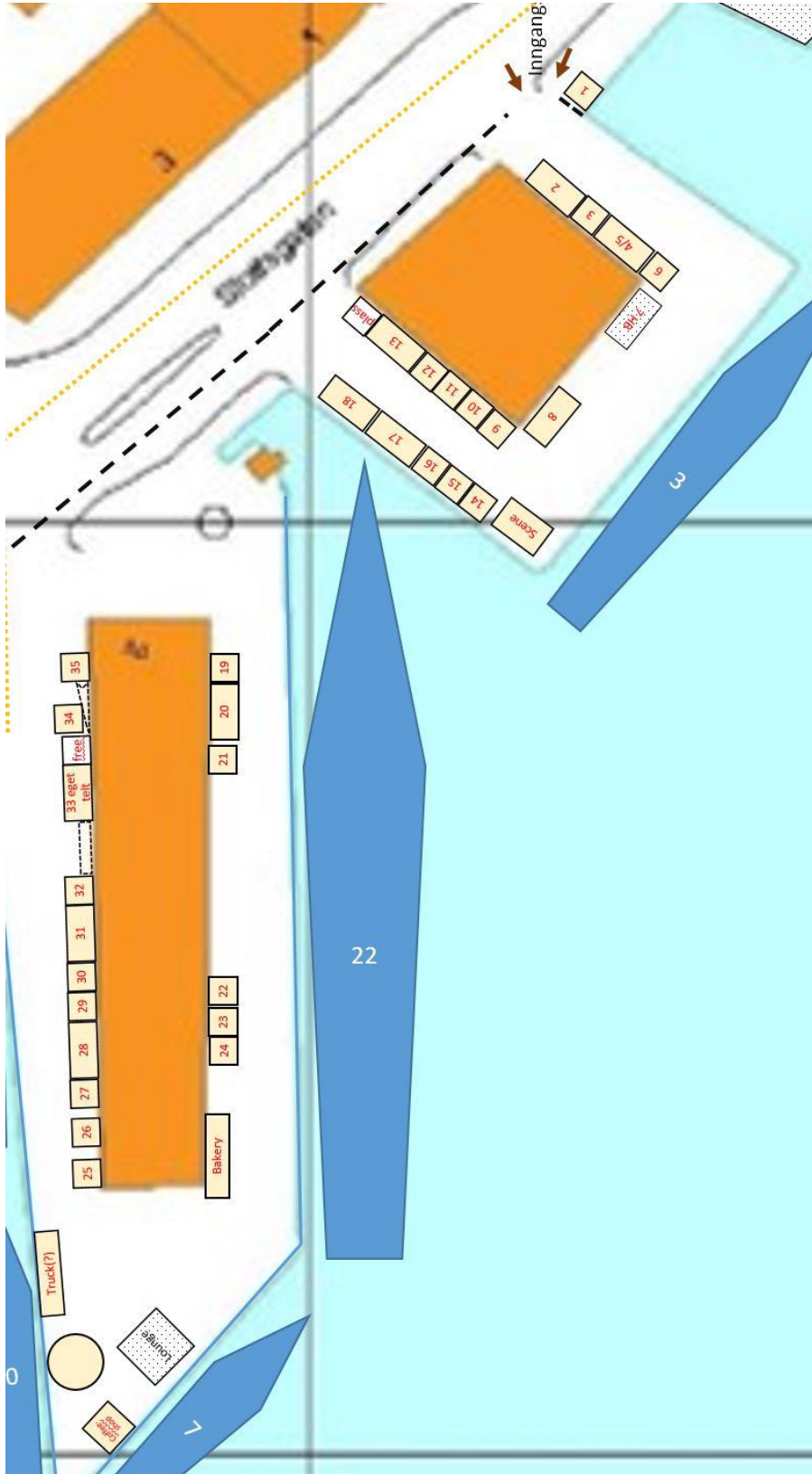

## **Fire instructions Hansa Market**

**All participants must know this information**

### **Emergency line fire department 110**

1. All tents must know where the closest fire extinguisher is to their tent.
2. Driving lanes and area for the public must be open. Participants cannot place anything outside their tent/stall, unless agreed upon in beforehand with the Hanseatic Office in Bergen.
3. Fire bowls, hydrants and other extinguisher equipment must not be covered or blocked
4. There must not be used old or worn out electrical equipment and we do not want multi-sockets. Cables on street level must be covered to avoid accidents.
5. No combustible materials close to heat sources.
6. It is not allowed to store gas in tents outside opening hours.
7. Please put your garbage into the assigned containers.
8. All participants must follow orders from the Hanseatic Days Staff and the authorities.
9. This fire instruction must be visible in all the tents. We will provide a laminated specimen.
